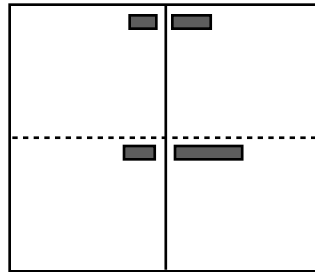

Things Living Things Need Organizer

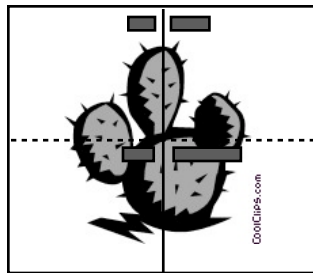
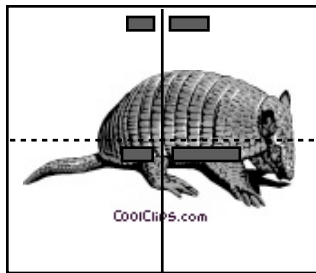
By now, you should have been given a piece of paper that has printing on one side. You will be adding information and drawings to this paper to show examples of the different things all living things need to survive. Follow the instructions in the checklist below, and check off each step as you complete it.

- 1) Put the paper in front of you so the side with a space for your name is on the back. Fold the ends of the paper vertically along the dotted lines on the left and right of the back side so the edges of the paper meet in the center. You should now see the words "air", "water", "food", and "a place to live", as well as a dashed line going across the middle of the paper.



(Name is now hiding on the back)

- 2) Make a color drawing of some sort of living thing (like a plant or an animal) on the cover. Do NOT copy the examples below of an armadillo or a cactus!



- 3) With scissors, cut each of the dashed lines so you can peek under the flaps.
- 4) Under the flap for **air**, make a colored drawing to show how the living thing gets its air.
- 5) Under the flap for **water**, make a colored drawing to show how the living thing gets its water.
- 6) Under the flap for **food**, make a colored drawing to show how the living thing gets its food.
- 7) Under the flap for **a place to live**, make a colored drawing to show where the living thing lives.
- 8) Put your name and period on the back of the organizer, and turn it in.
